

## Flash Film submission guide 2012

### Brief Guidelines

1. Flash Film is open to all filmmakers. There is an open category and a category for under 18s.
2. The film must be up to 60 seconds long. Longer work will be disqualified.
3. The winning films and up to four shortlisted films in each category will be shown on the big screen, and filmmakers will be invited to talk about their work at a special Flash Film event, as part of the From Page to Screen Festival (11-15 April 2011).
4. The entry fee is £5 per Flash Film, payable via PayPal. There is no entry limit.

### Dates

1. Submissions are open from 26 November 2011.
2. The closing date for submissions is midnight on 23 March 2012 .
3. Winners will be announced in April 2011.

### Flash Film Judges

1. Flash Film entries will be judged by the festival committee.
2. The judges are looking for innovative and creative adaptations of the texts.
3. There will be up to five films in each category shortlisted and screened at the festival, with one overall winner and a youth prize for under 18s.
4. The winners will be selected by the Guest Director of the festival, Francine Stock.

## The Prize

1. The overall winner will receive a cash prize of £500. The Youth Prize winner will receive £100.
2. The four runners-up will enjoy:
  - Publicity related to the festival
  - The opportunity to have their work shown on a cinema screen
  - The opportunity to discuss their work in public
  - Their work promoted on the festival website and The Bridport Prize website

## How to enter

1. Select and download a Flash Fiction text
2. Make your movie
3. Upload it to the Flash Film group on Vimeo
4. Submit your entry form
5. Pay your £5 entry fee.

After that, you can do it again for another story. Or go and watch some of the entries on Vimeo. We'll be in touch with the shortlisted filmmakers in late March or early April.
